#### **Reg. 1 Organiser**

The 32. FIM Meeting is organised by Sveriges Motorcyklister (SMC)

On behalf of the Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM) and Touring and Leisure Commission (CTL), the event will be held from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> of June 2014 according to the FIM Code for Touristic Gatherings (hereafter known as CTG) – FIM Meritum Meeting section; to the rules of the FIM, to these Supplementary Regulations and to the FIM Environmental Code.

## Reg. 2 Participation

Eligible at FIM-Meeting are motorcyclist:

- All members of a bikers National Motorcycle Federation (FMN) and their passengers who are holders distinction “Meritum” or “Co-Meritum”
- Motorcyclist of which are not yet holding a distinction “Meritum” or “Co-Meritum if they are accompanying people already in possession of these distinctions.

## Reg. 3 Entries

Individual entries will be made on the form made available for this purpose (or the duplicate) which will be delivered to the FMNs on the official website by the organiser (CTG Rally Art. 5).

Participants can submit their entries by their National Motorcycle Federation (FM) or directly to the organiser (Address see Reg. 1).

## Reg. 4 Entry fee

The entry fee is 1220 SEK (Swedish crowns). The amount is fixed in SEK.

Children between the ages of 8 and 12 will pay 50 % of the adult entrance fee. Children under the age of 8 will be admitted free of charge.

In case of non-participation, the entry fee is not refundable.

The entry fee will be paid in full (100 %) by the participant before March 31, 2014 to the following account:

## Reg. 5 Closing date for entries

The deadline for the entries and booking of the accommodation is the March 31, 2014

For incoming entries after this date, the organiser decides on participation.

## Reg. 6 Services for participants

Every participant who has paid the registration fee will receive:

### **Reg. 7 Accommodation**
